### **Superintendent's Report:**

### 1. Academic Achievement:

a. Gilmer High School: GHS Principal Mr. Derek Bowen presented the Board with a video consisting of student testimonies about how the opportunities and activities offered at GHS along with staff has contributed to student success.

#### 2. Parent and Community Engagement:

- a. Family Literacy Night: Dr. Ridley announced that the community wide Family Literacy Night will be held on April 28, 2023 at Huff Mosley Stadium. Details for the event are being finalized and will be made available to the public when they become available.
- b. 2024-2025 Calendar Proposal: Dr. Ridley presented the Board with 3 draft academic calendars for the 2024-2025 school year. Dr. Ridley noted that upon Boards approval on Thursday at the Regular Session drafts will be sent to employees for vote on preferred calendar.

## 3. Operational Effectiveness:

- a. High Performing Workforce:
  - i. Personnel: Dr. Ridley noted that personnel will be discussed in Executive Session.

# b. Operational Services:

- i. Gilmer High School Renovation Resolution: Dr. Ridley presented the Board with the Gilmer High School Renovation Resolution. The purpose of the resolution is to officially close out the 3-phase renovation at GHS and receive reimbursement from the State of Georgia. Dr. Ridley noted a recommendation to approve the resolution will be made at the Regular Session on Thursday March 16, 2023.
- ii. Lawncare Proposal: Dr. Ridley spoke to the Board regarding proposals received for lawncare for the district. Dr. Ridley noted that if it is the Boards wishes the Lawncare Proposals will be voted upon at the Regular Session, Thursday March 16, 2023.
- iii. Southwest Property Transfer: Dr. Ridley spoke to the Board regarding the Southwest property that currently houses North Georgia Regional Educational Services Agency (NGRESA). Dr. Ridley explained the terms and conditions of the transfer which would allow NGRESA to obtain the districts property for \$1. Upon vacancy NGRESA will relinquish the property back to Gilmer County Schools. Dr. Ridley noted a recommendation for approval will be made at the Regular Session on Thursday March 16, 2023.
- iv. Vehicle Surplus: Dr. Ridley explained to the Board that the vehicle is no longer in commission and a recommendation for approval will be made at the Regular Session on Thursday March 16, 2023.
- v. Compliance/Policy (First Reading): The following policies were presented for first reading in order to comply with recent changes in the law and/or GSBA recommendations to update the current wording:
  - Policy BDH Suspension of Policies Waivers
  - Policy BE School Board Records
  - Policy ED Student Transportation Management

Dr. Ridley explained that these policies will be posted on the GCSS Website for public review and comment before a second reading at the Board of Education Work Session at next month's meeting. Subject to feedback and public deliberations, these will be voted upon at the Regular Session in April.

- vi. Compliance/Policy (Second Reading): Policies presented for first readings in February and have been posted on the GCSS website for public comment and also sent to GSBA for legal counsel review.

The policies have been on the district website since the meeting in February. All policies have been submitted to GSBA legal counsel for review. No changes received from GSBA legal counsel and no public input was received. Dr. Ridley asked that these policies be moved to the Consent Agenda and
